| <b>EPHESUS</b>      | The One who holds the seven stars in His right hand, the One who walks among the seven golden lampstands<br>2:1              | I know your deeds and your toil and perseverance, and that you cannot endure evil men, and you put to the test those who call themselves apostles<br>2:2 | But I have this against you, that you have left your first love.<br>2:4   | Repent and do the deeds you did at first; or else I am coming to you, and will remove your lampstand out of its place<br>2:5   | To him who overcomes, I will grant to eat of the tree of life, which is in the Paradise of God.<br>2:7  |
| <b>SMYRNA</b>       | The first and the last, who was dead, and has come to life<br>2:8  | I know your tribulation and your poverty (but you are rich)<br>2:9   | <i>[I know ... the blasphemy by those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan.]</i><br>2:9  | Behold, the devil is about to cast some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation ten days<br>2:10   | Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.<br>2:10   |
| <b>PERGAMUM</b>     | The One who has the sharp two-edged sword<br>2:12  | I know where you dwell, where Satan's throne is; and you hold fast My name, and did not deny My faith<br>2:13  | You also have some who hold the teaching of Balaam ... you also have some who in the same way hold the teaching of the Nicolaitans<br>2:14-15   | Repent therefore; or else I am coming to you quickly, and I will make war against them with the sword of My mouth<br>2:16  | I will give some of the hidden manna, and I will give him a white stone, and a new name written on the stone which no one knows but he who receives it.<br>2:17   |
| <b>THYATIRA</b>     | The Son of God, who has eyes like a flame of fire, and His feet are like burnished bronze<br>2:18                            | I know your deeds, and your love and faith and service and perseverance, and that your deeds of late are greater than at first.<br>2:19                  | You tolerate the woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, and she teaches and leads My bond-servants astray, so that they commit acts of immorality and eat things sacrificed to idols.<br>2:20           | I will cast her upon a bed of sickness, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they repent of her deeds.<br>2:22  | He who overcomes, and he who keeps My deeds until the end, to him I will give authority over the nations ... and I will give him the morning star.<br>2:26-28   |
| <b>SARDIS</b>       | He who has the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars<br>3:1  | You have a few people in Sardis who have not soiled their garments; and they will walk with Me in white; for they are worthy.<br>3:4                     | I know your deeds, that you have a name that you are alive, but you are dead.<br>3:1  | Remember therefore what you have received and heard; and keep it, and repent. If therefore you will not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what hour I will come upon you.<br>3:3 | He who overcomes shall thus be clothed in white garments; and I will not erase his name from the book of life, and I will confess his name before My Father, and before His angels.<br>3:5  |
| <b>PHILADELPHIA</b> | He who is holy, who is true, who has the key of David, who opens and no one will shut, and who shuts and no one opens<br>3:7 | You have a little power, and have kept My word, and have not denied My name.<br>3:8  | <i>[I will cause those of the synagogue of Satan, who say that they are Jews, and are not, but lie-- behold, I will make them to come and bow down at your feet, and to know that I have loved you.]</i><br>3:9 | I am coming quickly; hold fast what you have, in order that no one take your crown.<br>3:11  | I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and I will write upon him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God, and My new name.<br>3:12 |
| <b>LAODICEA</b>     | The Amen, the faithful and true Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God<br>3:14  |  | Because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of My mouth ... you do not know that you are wretched and miserable and poor and blind and naked<br>3:15-17                             | Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline; be zealous therefore, and repent.<br>3:19   | I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.<br>3:21   |
