FAMILY DIVISIONS Mat.10:33-37. " I did not come to bring peace, but a sword"
HIS OWN PEOPLE DID NOT RECEIVE HIM He came to His own, and those who were His own did not receive Him. Joh 1:11 Only a remnant of Jewish people followed Him. Rom.11:5-8
RELIGIOUS LEADERS' OPPOSED HIM Sought to destroy Him before he grew up. Mat.2:16 Attempted to discredit Him. Mat.10:25, 5:11 Tried to trap Him on numerous occasions. Mat.22:15; Mar.12:13 Sought false testimony concerning Him. Mat.26:59 Undertook to kill Him. Mat.26:3-4 Threatened those who believed in Him. Joh.9:22, 12:42-43
SCENE SET FOR MAN'S REDEMPTION His coming was God's gift to mankind. Joh.3:16 Salvation from sin made possible. Luk.1:77, Act.4:12, 1Jo.5:12-13
BECOMING SONS OF GOD MADE A REALITY "All are children of God by faith in Christ Jesus." Gal.3:26-27, Rom.8:16

THE COURSE OF HISTORY CHANGED
